



Upcycling Craft



QV POT PLANTER HERB GARDEN

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 3 x QV Cream pump pack (or as many as you have)
- Chalkboard paint
- Paintbrush
- 1 x pack of chalk
- Masking tape
- Sand Paper
- Scissors
- Various herbs/plants of your choice

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove labels from product.
2. Cut the top of the container/s off, so the pump is removed.
3. Clean out the container/s with water and leave to dry.
4. Sand the edges to smooth out any sharp or rough spots.
5. Remove the bottom blue end of the bottle, and using the scissors, carefully poke 4 small holes in the cone, to allow for water drainage. Re-connect the blue end once complete.
6. Use masking tape to outline a horizontal rectangle on the centre of the planter pot.
7. Paint over the outlined rectangle with Chalkboard paint. (You can also use a label sticker if you don't have chalkboard paint)
8. Let this dry, remove the tape and then draw your label on with the chalk.
9. Plant your herbs and watch them grow!
